LETTER FROM THE MONSIGNOR

MD when the Son of man shall come in his majesty, and all the angels with him, then shall he sit upon the seat of his majesty. – S. Matthew 25:31

MORE than several years ago Dom Anselm Marie, the Benedictine Monk we protect, and I were discussing the feasts of Christ the King. I say "feasts" because there are feasts indeed many that proclaim the Kingship of Our Lord Jesus Christ; from His Nativity, His Transfiguration, His triumphant entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday and His glorious Resurrection, to name just a few.

This month is the Month of the Holy Rosary and the month of the Kingship of Our Lord Jesus Christ. Many people, especially non-Catholics, misunderstand that the Holy Rosary is only about Our Lady, however, Our Lady is only explicitly mentioned in seven of the eight mysteries (Annunciation. Visitation. Nativity, Presentation, Finding in the Temple, Assumption and Coronation) and we believe she is implicitly in three mysteries (Carrying of the Cross, Crucifixion, Descent of the Holy Ghost). The devotion of the Holy Rosary is actually about Our Blessed Lady's active role in the Life of Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, from accepting Him into her body by the power of the Lord the Holy Ghost at the *Annunciation* through her glorious heavenly *Coronation* at His hands. She is the Queen of Heaven at the pleasure of her Son, King of Heaven *and* Earth, of Whose Kingdom there is no end (S. Luke 1:33).

When the western world still clung to the One, True Church there was a tangible Christendom that extended through the Middle East, where the faith thrived until the murderous Mohammedans put Christians to the sword. This was repeated by the German English princes who national churches wanted rather than the Universal Church of Jesus Christ; the Protest-ants assaulted Catholics, who, alas, were forced to

defend themselves. The growth of Nationalism began and continues under the influence of Protest-antism and weak and disordered [not true] Catholicism. The courageous and Holy Father, Pius XI, writes these prophetic words concerning nationalism:

Whoever exalts race, or the people, or the State, or a particular form of State, or the depositories of power, or any other fundamental value of the human community however necessary and honourable be their function in worldly things - whoever raises these notions above their standard value and divinizes them to an idolatrous level, distorts and perverts an order of the world planned and created by God; he is far from the True Faith in God and from the concept of life which that faith upholds (Mit Brennender Sorge, no.8, 14 March 1937).

May we all earnestly pray and work for the restoration of the Empire of the Lord!

twentieth century.

Since these are actually two questions I will do my best to answer them separately: First, every Protest-ant sect was founded through an act of rebellion and heresy, the very same spirit that entered the devil when he rebelled against God, therefore every one of these "religions" has been founded, alas, by the devil. These rebellions began at the end of the 15th century and continue their error to this day. At the end of this section I have added the very interesting **How** Old is Your Church? chart which I think you and the other readers will find interesting.

Your second question concerns the heresy Universal Salvation. which erroneously teaches that everyone goes to heaven. This contradicts Our Lord Himself, Who warns us about the hell, or Gehenna on many occasions, in fact the Lord mentions hell and damnation more than anyone else in the Bible. We know that

very few people actually go to heaven: And a certain man said to Him: Lord, are they few that are saved? But He said to them: Strive to enter by the narrow gate; for many, I say to you, shall seek to enter, and shall not be able. But when the master of the house shall be gone in, and shall shut the door, you shall begin to stand without, and knock at the door, saying: Lord, open to us. And he answering, shall say to you: I know you not, whence you are (S. Luke 13:23 - 25). This wicked practice of telling people that their loved one is in heaven is to make people feel better about death rather than teach them of death's reality and their judgment by God.

- If you are a Lutheran, Martin Luther, an apostate of the Roman Catholic Church, founded your religion in Germany, in the year 1517.
- If you are a Mennonite, your church began in Switzerland with Grebel, Mantz, and Blaurock, in the year 1525.
- If you belong to the Church of England, also know as Anglican, your religion began with King Henry VIII in 1534, who established his own church because the Pope could not grant him a divorce with the right to remarry.
- If you are a Presbyterian, your religion was founded by John Knox, in Scotland, in the year 1560.

- If you are a Universalist, John Murray founded your religion in New Jersey, in 1770.
- If you are an Evangelical, you owe the founding of your religion to Jacob Albright, in Pennsylvania, in 1803.
- If you are a Mormon (a "Latter Day Saint"), then Joseph Smith started your religion in Palmyra, New York, in 1829.
- If you are a Seventh Day Adventist, your religion originated in New York, by William Miller, in 1831.
- If you worship with the Salvation Army sect, then you acknowledge William Booth in London as your originator, in 1865.
- If you are a Jehovah Witness, then your church was founded by Charles Taze Russell, in 1872, and renamed in 1931 by Judge Rutherford, his successor.
- If you are a Christian Scientist, then Mary Baker Eddy founded your religion in Massachusetts, in 1879.
- If you belong to the Assembly of God religion, then a General Assembly in Arkansas started it in 1914.
- If you claim the Church of the Nazarene as your religion, then Union at General Assembly launched it in 1919.
- If you are an Evangelical Reformed, then Union at General Assembly created it in 1934.
- If you belong to "Pentecostal Gospel," your religion is one of

- the hundreds of new sects founded by men in the last 100 years.
- If you are a Roman Catholic, you know that your religion was founded in the year 33 by Our Lord Jesus Christ.

In order to assist the faithful following Holy Mass with their hand missals here are the Sunday Masses for August:

6 October 2019: 17th Sunday after Pentecost: commemoration of S. Bruno at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

13 October 2019: 18th Sunday after Pentecost: commemoration of S. Edward then the Suffrage of the Saints at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

20 October 2019:
19th Sunday after Pentecost:
commemoration of S. John
Cantius, then for the
Propagation of the Faith at the
Collect, Secret and
Postcommunion.


27 October 2019:

Christ the King: commemoration of the 20th Sunday after Pentecost then the Suffrage of the Saints at the Collect, Secret and Postcommunion.

To correctly participate at Holy Mass one *silently* unites his prayers with those of the Church through pious and attentive meditation of the prayers and reading of Holy Mass.

If you are unsure how to correctly set your hand missal arrive early for Holy Mass and ask the Monsignor to assist you. It is also important to become familiar with the Ordinary of the Mass, those parts that never change, i.e.: Kyrie, Creed. Sanctus. Gloria. Benedictus, and the Agnus Dei. And of course the Canon of the Mass, and the Propers of the Mass, those which vary according to the feasts of the day, i.e., Introit, Collect(s)(after the Gloria or Dominus Vobiscum), Epistle, Gradual, Alleluia, Tract or Sequence, Gospel, Secret, Communion Verse and Post Communion. On many feasts or days there are Commemorations (additional prayers) at the Secret Collect, and Postcommunion. The careful attention to these prayers and readings will help one enter deeper spiritual relationship with the Holy Liturgy, the Saints and Mysteries of God.
